

- a. **Mission.** To direct and support the activities of the RGJ Association, through its General Committee, and support the Museum and other legacy and memorial elements of the Regiment, in order to safeguard the traditions of the Royal Green Jackets, and foster comradeship between veteran fellow Riflemen.
- b. **Composition.** The Executive Committee shall consist of the President of the Association as Chairman, the Chairman of the General Committee, an elected representative of the Association's Branches, the Chairman of the RGJ (Rifles) Museum, a member of the Website and Communications Team, a representative of the Former Regiments, the Secretary and not more than two other members of the RGJ Association. Four members of the Committee are required to form a Quorum.
- c. **Objectives:**
  - i. To encourage and sustain membership of the RGJ Association.
  - ii. To provide communication for and between veterans through the Regimental website and annual journal/Ezine.
  - iii. To safeguard our regimental traditions and values, and as required, to provide input to Col Comdt The Rifles and RHQ The Rifles.
  - iv. To support the annual Veterans' Reunion and Officers Dining Club dinner.
  - v. To help support the running costs of the RGJ (Rifles) Museum until the future of the Museum is clearly determined.
  - vi. To maintain the Regimental Memorial at the National Memorial Arboretum Alrewas and the Garden of Remembrance at Winchester.
  - vii. To oversee the income and capital of the RGJ Management Fund, review the policy and priorities for spending, and annually allocate resources as required.
  - viii. To support other RGJ Association activities as the Executive Committee deems appropriate.

**6. The General Committee.** The activities of the RGJ Association shall be managed by a General Committee, of members of the Association approved by the Executive Committee. It is to supervise and coordinate the work of the RGJ Association, with power to spend money within the limits authorised annually by Executive Committee.

- a. **Mission.** To provide the means whereby Riflemen of all ranks who are serving, or have at anytime served in the Regiment or in any Affiliated Regiment can continue to be part of the "Green Jacket Family" through maintaining contact with the Regiment and friends.
- b. **Composition.** The Committee, six members of which are required to form a Quorum, shall consist of:
  - i. The Chairman and his Deputy.
  - ii. The Secretary.
  - iii. The Treasurer/Membership Secretary.
  - iv. The Association Website/Database Manager.
  - v. At least one representative from each of the Branches (including the Internet Branch) making up the Association.
  - vi. A representative from the RGJ (Rifles) Museum "In attendance".
