vii. A representative from its other sub committees as required.

## c. Objectives:

- To implement the objectives and policies set out by the Executive Committee for the RGJ Association.
- ii. To bring to the notice of all persons who are serving or who have served with the Regiment, or with any Affiliated Regiment, the existence of the RGJ Association and to encourage and sustain membership of the RGJ Association.
- iii. To provide an environment through which past members of the Regiment and of Affiliated Regiments can get together and maintain contact with each other and the Regiment. This is achieved through the establishment of Branches in all parts of the United Kingdom and abroad, where this is feasible, to foster a bond of comradeship between all who have served as Riflemen in the Royal Green Jackets in any capacity whatsoever.
- iv. To encourage attendance at and organise social and commemorative events either centrally or through the Regional Branches.
- v. To implement a Communications Plan for and between veterans through the RGJ Association website and by the publication of an annual journal/Ezine (s).
- vi. To organise the annual Veterans' Reunion and Officers Dining Club dinner.
- vii. To maintain the Regimental Memorial at the National Memorial Arboretum Alrewas and the Garden of Remembrance at Winchester.
- viii. Based on the priorities for spending, to bid to the Executive Committee annually for an allocation of resources to support the activities of the Association and its Branches.
- ix. To support other RGJA activities as the Executive Committee deems appropriate.
- 7. **The General Committee Appointments.** The appointments of Chairman, Deputy Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, Membership Secretary, Association Website/Database Manager and members of the Committee are made in accordance with this rule:
  - a. The Chairman and his Deputy are retired RGJ officers and are appointed by the Executive Committee of the RGJ Association. Their terms of office shall be for a period normally not less than three years.
  - b. The Secretary to the Committee to be a retired RGJ officer, preferably on the Regimental Headquarters staff.
  - c. The Association Treasurer and Membership Secretary are not required to have served in the Royal Green Jackets. He or she shall be paid an honorarium, agreed by the Executive Committee, for services rendered. (This post could be merged, if circumstances require in the future, with the Secretary of the Committee)
  - d. The Association Database/Website Manager is a member of the Association.
  - e. Branch Representatives are elected by the individual Branch membership.
  - The General Committee shall appoint new members of the Committee as required.
  - g. The General Committee will elect annually a branch representative to be a member of the Executive Committee.
- 8. **Sub-Committees.** The Executive Committee and the General Committee may appoint sub-committees for special purposes when required. Membership of any such sub-committee shall be restricted to members of the Association, and will include:
